TRAV GOLD RIDING CERTIFICATE CRITERIA

Level THREE (Independent, Model to others)

LESSON SKILLS

Grooming

Grooms entire horse in sequential order

Picks out all four feet of horse

Wipes off bridle & reins using (saddle) soap & water after each lesson

Disassembles saddle into parts, wipes down all parts with (saddle) soap & water after lesson

Trims horse's muzzle & indicates areas that are clipped on a regular basis

Describes proper care of horse after winter & summer lesson; gives reasons why

Tacking

Takes bridle on/off horse independently

Takes saddle on/off horse independently

Safety Rules

Demonstrates/ gives reason for moving to different area of ring when too close to another horse

Demonstrates/gives reason for an emergency dismount

Demonstrates /describes proper spacing for horse & rider when leading horse; maneuvering past fences, through gates, & around obstacles

Demonstrates/describes proper spacing for horse & rider when riding a horse and maneuvering past fences, through gates & around obstacles.

Leading

Performs walk/trot/jog/walk transition for 50 feet while leading the horse

Leads from left /right sides of horse

Halts horse with front feet square

Halts horse with both front &back feet square

Mounting

Demonstrates ability to adjust stirrup leathers/fenders to correct length using arm as a measurement

Demonstrates all steps of mounting independently

Gathers reins to appropriate length to establish contact with horse's mouth

Dismounting

Maintains contact with reins when dismounting horse

Uses hands& arms to lift his/her bodyweight off saddle for dismount

Runs up/places up stirrups independently after dismounting horse

Knowledge

Names/ locates (skirt, stirrup leather/ fender, & knee roll) of saddle

Names /locates (cheek pieces & keepers) on bridle

Names/ locates (fetlock, hock, knee, gaskin, flank, &pastern) on horse



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Explains reasons for different rations of feed (amount of work performed, size of horse)

Explains reasons for additional nutritional supplements (older horses, mares in foal, heavily worked horses)

Riding Skills

Cues horse (walk, halt, trot/jog and back up) for movement patterns

Completes figure eight (walk& trot/jog) without using obstacles for guidance

Performs posting trot (on correct diagonal)/ working jog (entire length of the ring, over cavelettis and over ground poles)

Changes direction (trotting/jogging across the ring, on a diagonal line, & half circle both ways)

Rides complete circle (sitting & posting trot; jog/ working jog) in both directions

Maintains two-point position (trotting) entire length of ring

Demonstrates working walk (both directions)

Halts horse with front feet square (on rail & in center of ring)

Backs horse four stride lengths (in a straight line on trail & in center of ring)

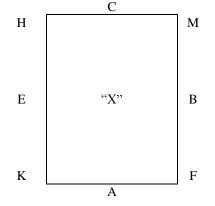
Rides horse (outside ring, up &down hills & through gates)

Retrieves stirrups (without using hands)

Maintains balanced, seated position (while riding bareback at walk)

Completes 12-step dressage pattern in correct sequence

Sample Pattern in the dressage ring:



Start at X, Proceed at walk to C

C Turn left

H-E-K Continue at working walk

K Sitting trot/jog

A Circle left 20 meters through X

A-F Continue sitting trot/jog

F-B-M Posting trot/ working jog

M Working Walk

C-H Continue at working walk

H-X-F Change direction

F Sitting trot/jog

A Circle right 20 meters through X

A-K Continue sitting trot/jog

K-E-H Posting trot/working jog

H Walk C Halt
